Four concurrent discussions on the hottest topics in consumer financial services

Session 1 – Mortgage Servicing and Bankruptcy – Regency Ballroom A

This session would discuss current events in mortgage lending and servicing, including TRID, *Lighthouse* (marketing services agreements), Chapter 13 Trustee inquiries and any other topics of current interest.

Session 2 – Online and small business lending – Regency Ballroom B

A discussion of the Treasury Department’s RFI on Online Marketplace Lending, the CFPB’s collection of small business loan data, and the potential expansion of consumer regulations to small business loans.

Session 3 – Madden v. Midland – Atlanta

A discussion of *Madden v. Midland*. This case did not follow the “valid when made” doctrine and removed NBA preemption, exposing a debt purchaser to usury claims.

Session 4 – TCPA Update - New Orleans
